

APAC – VENDOR AND SERVICE PROVIDER REPRESENTATIVE PRIVACY NOTICE

This Privacy Notice describes how TPG (“we” or “us”) collects and uses the personal data of representatives of our vendors and services providers (“Vendor Representatives”).

The TPG entity processing your data for the purposes described in this notice is responsible for such processing, and can be contacted using the details provided below.

Personal data we collect about you

In connection with our relationships with our vendors, we collect and use limited personal data about Vendor Representatives from time to time. This personal data may include a Vendor Representative’s name, contact details (address, email address and phone number), government-issued identification number, bank account information, and photographs, as well as the contents of any electronic communications with TPG including but not limited to Bloomberg Messaging, Zoom, WhatsApp, WeChat, and any other messaging platform.

We may collect sensitive data about you, including information relating to health, when you visit our properties. Where required by law, we will seek your consent to do so.

How we use your personal data

We use the personal data that we collect about Vendor Representatives to facilitate our relationship and communication with the vendor, and to retain a record of our communications with the vendor. We also use the personal data that we collect about Vendor Representatives in connection with performance of background checks and carrying out due diligence and payment risk assessments in relation to the vendor. We may also use the photographs of Vendor Representatives for security purposes if we need to grant Vendor Representatives access to any of our properties.

Where we are required or permitted to do so by law, we process sensitive data relating to the health of our Vendor Representatives in order to protect the health and safety of TPG staff and visitors to our properties.

Data sharing

We may share personal data about Vendor Representatives with:

- Other TPG entities; and
- Service providers that perform services on our behalf.

We may share personal data with service providers that perform services on our behalf such as payment service providers, analytics providers, business communications archiving providers, and hosting providers.

To the extent required by law, we will obtain your consent to share your personal data with these parties.

In addition, we may disclose personal data about you (a) if we are required or permitted to do so by law or legal process, for example due to a court order or a request from a law enforcement agency, (b) when we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to prevent physical harm or financial loss, (c) in connection with an investigation of suspected or actual fraudulent or other illegal activity, and (d) in the event we sell or transfer all or a portion of our business or assets (including in the event of a reorganization, dissolution, or liquidation).

Data transfers

We may transfer the personal data that we collect about you to recipients in countries other than the country in which the personal data originally was collected, including the United States of America, China, Hong Kong, Australia, India, Singapore and South Korea. Those countries may not have the same data protection laws as the country in which you initially provided the personal data. When we transfer your personal data to recipients in other countries (such as the U.S.), we will protect that personal data as described in this Notice and, where required by law, seek your consent to transfer your personal information.

Your rights and choices

Subject to applicable law, you may have the right to request:

- confirmation of whether we process personal data relating to you and, if so, to request a copy of that personal data;
- that we rectify or update your personal data that is inaccurate, incomplete or outdated; and
- that we erase your personal data in certain circumstances, such as where we collected personal data on the basis of your consent and you withdraw that consent;

- withdrawal of your consent where you have given us consent to process your personal data.

If you wish to exercise any of your data protection rights or if you consider that we have processed your personal data in violation of applicable law, please contact us as detailed in the "How to contact us" section below. Subject to applicable law, you may also be able to lodge a complaint with the personal data protection authority in your country.

Who is Responsible for your Personal Data

The TPG entity to which you or your organisation provides services is responsible for the use of your personal data under applicable data protection law, which may be TPG Capital (S) Pte.
